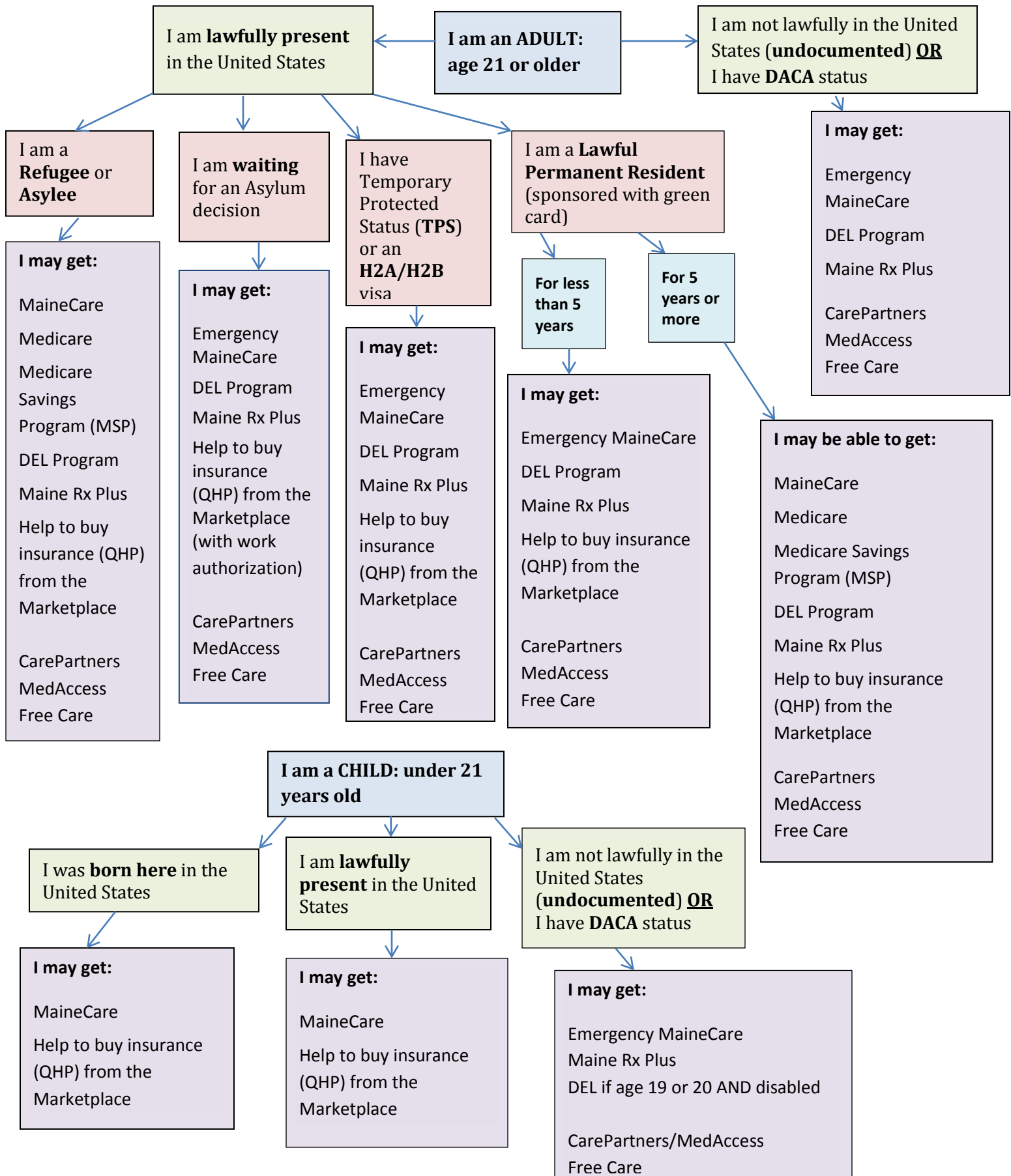






What kind of HELP can I get to pay for Health Care?




The Marketplace = One application  to get help to pay for health care  and medicine 



MaineCare = Public insurance that pays for health care  and medicine  if you have low income

Emergency MaineCare = Only pays for serious health care emergencies

Medicare = Public insurance that helps pay for health care  and medicine  if you are elderly 



OR have a disability 


Medicare Savings Program (MSP) = Helps pay for health care  and medicine  if you are

elderly  OR have a disability  AND have Medicare.



Legal Services for the Elderly (LSE) can help you enroll (Phone: 1-877-774-7772)

Low Cost Drugs for the Elderly or Disabled (DEL) Program = Helps pay for medicine  if

you are elderly  (over 62) or if you have a disability 


Maine Rx Plus = Helps pay part of the cost for medicine 

Apply for DEL and Maine Rx Plus at the DHHS Office (Phone: 1-866-796-2463)


Qualified Health Plan (QHP) = Private insurance to help pay for health care  and medicine 

Help to Buy Insurance from the Marketplace = Help to pay for a Qualified Health Plan (QHP)


when you fill out the Marketplace application  if you have low income

CarePartners = Helps pay for health care  if you can't get MaineCare, Medicare, or private insurance

Call CarePartners to enroll (Phone: 1-877-626-1684)

MedAccess = Helps pay for medicine  if you can't get the help you need from other programs

Call MedAccess to enroll (Phone: 1-877-275-1787)

Hospital Free Care = Limited free care provided by hospital facilities  for people with low income
